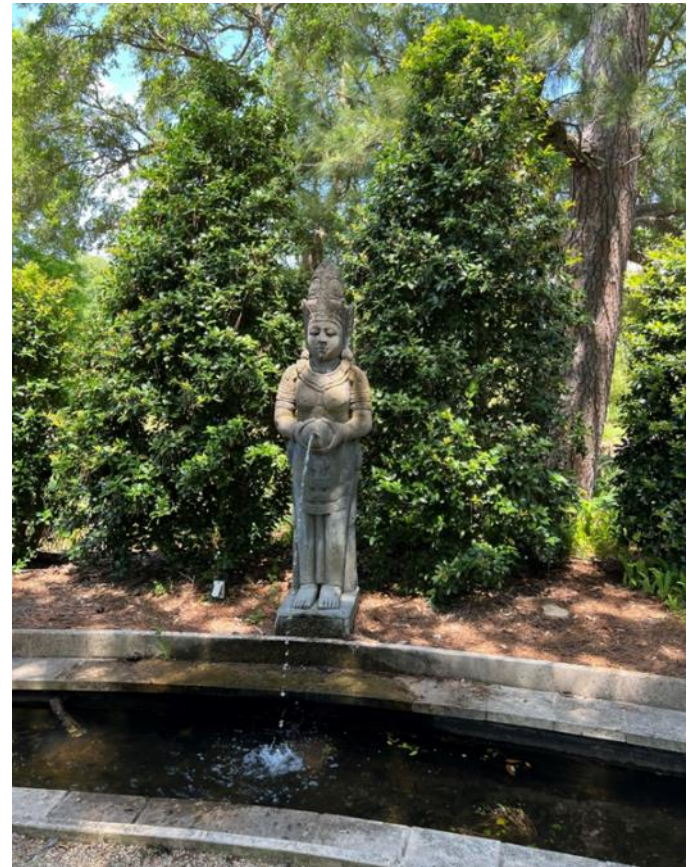

DISTRACTED DRIVING

Presented by Kevin Moore, EHS

Fleaux Services



April is Distracted Driving month. For our program for the April Desk and Derrick meeting, we were treated to a little education on Distracted Driving. Our speaker/presenter was Kevin Moore. Kevin is the EHS Manager with Fleaux Services.

Kevin began by explaining just how quickly you can lose control of your vehicle due to distraction. For instance, 5 seconds of looking away, reaching for some thing, talking on your phone (even hands free) or playing with your pet can carry you the length of a football field. These are just a few examples. There were so many examples of "distraction."

He listed facts such as:

1. You are 6 times more likely to have an accident while texting than from drunk driving,
2. 11 teens daily die from texting while driving,
3. 6 million people per year die from texting while driving,
4. 64% of all crashes in the US each year are caused by cell phone use behind the wheel (EVEN IF HANDS FREE).

Vehicles are the most dangerous weapons that companies own. So that company vehicle that your employee drives is YOUR weapon. This is why Fleaux Services now has both forward facing and driver facing cameras in all company vehicles. They greatly increase driver awareness and safety. And they are a great help on your company insurance too.

Kevin brought a film, Eight Seconds - One Fatal Distraction. This was a film actually taken of a driver of a big truck who looked down for eight seconds at a text that his wife had sent him. During that eight seconds he did not see the small car stopped at a red light in front of him. He did not know the car was there ... until he actually drove across the top of it ... going 63 mph. That eight seconds took one life and changed many others.

Kevin Moore is also a Smith Driving School instructor. He encouraged us to always remain aware of what our job is inside that vehicle. And safety is the main job, getting home at night the main goal.

Thank you, Kevin. I hope we all drove home just a little more aware of our actions behind the wheel.
