SURVEYING AND THE OIL & GAS INDUSTRY Will Merritt, Bud Short R-Squared Global

For our June membership meeting, we enjoyed being taught about just how much the surveying business has changed over the past 10, 5 and even 2 years. Our speakers were Will Merritt and Bud Short from R-Squared Global, a company of "innovative land surveyors and other things with delicate precision."

Mr. Short started us off with the topic of <u>Surveying Needs in the Oil and Gas Industry</u>. According to him every plat, including government entities providing location, requires surveying such as every pipeline easement, every electrical pole, every pit, and on and on and on.

In the past surveying was done with several people using ropes, poles, chains, and tape measures. Now it is done with laser lights, prisms, and Electronic Distance Machines (EDMs). A laser is shot and the EDM calculates the return speed/distance. When this is done you can get measurements, slopes and coordinates and send that information back to a computer at a Robotic Total Station. This can be done now with 1 man with a pole to take pictures and send information back to the computer.

New GPS systems can calculate distances from radio signals coming from satellites, which are moving about 2,000 mph. Mr. Short referred to the process as Real-Time Kinematic Surveying.

Next Mr. Merritt talked about the "nerdy" (his word) side of surveying. He explained his Remote Sensing Degree; Lidar, and airborne, ground-based and terrestrial programs. He explained that Lidar is a system for light detection and ranging, and it is used even in the medical field. He referred to that as Nano-Engineering.

Mr. Merritt then went into drones and how they are now used in surveying. Drones were first used for aerial photography, but now they gather information that can be used in all surveying. He explained Electro-Magnetic Spectrum using frequencies and how every object on earth emits frequencies. The drones not only take pictures, but they assist with pipeline route analysis and getting a "lay of the land."


Will Merritt started working for R-Squared Global in Monroe, Louisiana in 1995. He bought the company in 2020 starting with just 3 employees. They currently have 43 employees.

This presentation was very interesting. My article does not do justice to all the information that was presented. I am not really "nerdy" and yet I kind of understood it too! Ha
