#### HEAT ILLNESSES - - SIGNS, SYMPTOMS AND TREATMENTS

Doug Smith, Owner Blue Line Safety Solutions

As everyone knows, we have had record heat this summer like we have never seen before. It is dangerous to everyone, to pets, to our earth around us. Therefore, it seemed appropriate to invite Doug Smith, Owner of Blue Line Safety Solutions, to bring our presentation for the July meeting.

Doug Smith began his HSE career in 2008 starting as an HSE Coordinator with C&J Energy Services. Doug worked for C&J Energy Services for almost 10 years ending as one of their District HSE Managers before moving to Redback Coil Tubing in 2018. Doug then spent 2 ½ years with Redback Coil Tubing as their HSE Manager before starting Blue Line Safety Solutions in 2020. He also has been in law enforcement for 23 years serving with the Harrison County Sheriff's Office, the Marshall Police Department, and most recently as a part time police officer with the Waskom Police Department. He holds certificates as Certified Safety & Health Official - General Industry (CSHO) from the University of Texas at Arlington where he graduated in 2013. Doug has also holds a Master Peace Officer Certification from the State of Texas.

Doug spoke on what exactly is heat illness, who it affects, contributing factors, and even different types of heat illnesses. We learned that even mild illnesses such as heat rash and heat cramps can be signs of impending danger. But once you have reached heat exhaustion or heat stroke, now you are in trouble.

The best part of Doug's presentation (for me anyway) was the prevention tips. It is so much better to know the signs and keep yourself from getting overheated than to try to recover. Good tips for EVERYONE, not just oil-field workers or outside workers, include:

- Drink water every 15 minutes when outside
- Take periodic breaks in the shade
- Wear a hat and loose, lightweight clothing
- DO NOT consume alcohol or high caffeine and high sugar beverages
- Avoid the outside if at all possible
- Wear sunscreen
- Avoid hot, heavy meals
- Monitor urine output and color
- Pace yourself

There was so much more that we learned and should use in our everyday lives. Protect those kids when they are playing sports and your family when working outside. And do not forget the pets. Many of these same tips can work for them too.




