In delivering our eco-friendly, carbon neutral-to-negative solutions, we serve a critical need for project partners by delivering an auditable reduction in scope 3 emissions and satisfying the various contracting requirements tied to federal funding mandates. What sets us apart?

- The approach and materials used by New Dawn help our clients offset the majority, if not all, of the scope 3 emissions tied to each well site's P&A operations by incorporating carbon-rich soil amendments and emissions barriers into our surface remediation work.
- We have been active in the carbon markets and biochar industry for the last several years and have the infrastructure in place to source materials and provide third party, auditable accounting of the carbon credits and net offsets generated by our eco-friendly operations.

How exactly do carbon offsets get generated during P&A operations?

- The estimated average scope 3 emissions for a 2,500'-5,000' well equals 3 to 6 tons of CO₂.
- By incorporating high carbon biochar as an amendment and emission barrier over the plugged well bore, we will generate approximately 3–6 tons of CO₂ removal credits to offset the emissions generated by the cement and equipment operations of plugging the well.
- Each ton of biochar used generates approximately 2 tons of CO₂-e in offsets or credits.
- Due to the 2:1 ratio, using 3 tons of high carbon biochar would offset the equivalent of 6 tons of CO₂ generated during P&A operation.
- Net Scope 3 emissions, from example scenario above would be equal to 0 to -3 tons of CO₂ depending on the depth of the well and amount of cement used.

What should you expect?
