

Dear Members,

To recap the December program we had to cancel due to weather, our organization has a long history. Starting with 3 Clubs, we grew to hundreds of Clubs in 8 regions across the US and Canada. Membership topped out at over 11,000 with more than 3,000 attending annual conventions. Unfortunately as the industry suffered downturns, so too did our membership, and we currently find ourselves with 4 regions, 34 clubs and fewer than 700 members. If our organization is to survive and thrive again, it's up to us as members to step up, speak up, and participate.

Let's all step up. Join and work on a committee—club, regional and association. Special events such as our annual Clay Shoot and our invitational golf tournament are wonderful opportunities to spread the word about Desk and Derrick - the educational opportunities we offer for those employed in the oil and gas industry, and for fellowship with other club members.


