

The 2022 FRC is completing their review of the 2022 ADDC Financials and hopefully will be sent to membership soon. The 2023 FRC is finishing up the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter and will send out to membership this month, and the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2023 financials will be sent out by March 2024.

I would like to say "Thank You" to the 2023 ADDC Board for all their hard work, determination, and perseverance in making ADDC better than the year before. That is how we grow. I want to especially thank each member of our organization. ADDC would not be what it is today without each of you! Thank you for electing me to lead you and ADDC in 2023. I want to close this letter with one last leadership quote:


