The Word of the Day is.....Prepared! Preparing Northwest Louisiana for Natural Disasters



There are many hazards in our area. Tornadoes, Floods, Hurricanes, Fire, Hazardous Materials, terrorism and Natural gas leaks.

Tornadoes are very common in Louisiana. Caddo Parish is the top parish in Louisiana for Tornado activity. Listen for weather alerts in a warning you should immediately go to a safe shelter such as a basement, storm shelter or small interior room of the lowest level of a house or building. Stay away from windows, doors, and outside walls.

Flooding is the most common natural disaster in the United State and almost half of deaths happen in vehicles. Six inches of moving water will knock you down or cause most passenger vehicles to lose control or stall. One foot of water will float most cars, and two feet of rushing water will sweep most vehicles away. If you are in your vehicle and it becomes submerged in water, TRY NOT TO PAN-IC! Remain calm and wait for the vehicle to fill with water. If you are stranded on something above the floodwater wait for rescue. Remember TADD!! Turn around, Don't Drown!!!

Hurricane season reminders. Do not come near water that has contacted any downed power lines. If you are asked to leave your home, turn off utilities including gas and propane tanks. Make sure you know your evacuation routes. If you must evacuate, take your pets with you.

Wildfires, Humans cause 90% of wildfires and lighting is the biggest natural cause. You need three things to start a fire: Heat, oxygen, and a fuel source. They can happen anywhere in the US, and they burn 5-10 million acres every year.

Hazardous Material Leaks and Spills, 3.1 billion tons of hazardous materials (HazMat's) are transported by truck, rail, pipeline, and water. Many hazardous materials do not have a taste or an odor. HazMat's are any material that has properties that may result in risk or injury to health and/or destruction of life or facilities.

Active Shooter, RUN, HIDE, FIGHT, STOP THE BLEED. Average Age of School Shooter is 14 1/2 Years Old and most situations are over in less than 15 minutes. Have an escape route and plan in mind, evacuate regardless of whether others agree to follow, leave your belongings behind help others escape, if possible, prevent individuals from entering the area and follow the instructions of any law enforcement officers. If the Shooter is nearby, "Shelter in Place" is always the best option...but be prepared to move!!! You run if it's safe and hide if it's not. Remember lock the door, silence your cell phone, turn off any other source of noise like radios and TV's, hide behind large cabinets and desks and remain quiet. If you have to take action against the shooter, remember Fight/Defend/Attack. If your life is in imminent danger, attempt to disrupt and/or incapacitate the shooter. Acting as aggressively as possible against them by throwing items and improvising weapons, use anything you got to fight and yell. When law enforcement arrives: Follow LE Officer's instructions, put down any items you have in your hand and raise them above your head and spread your fingers. Do not make quick movements toward officers and avoid pointing, screaming, and/or yelling at officers, do not stop to ask officers for help or direction when evacuating, just proceed in the direction from which officers are entering the premises.

These are all things that our speaker Robert Elliott, Deputy Director of Bossier Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness recommends.






