


President's Letter:



### **Fun Facts About Oil Production**



Though the first successful oil drilling was in Titusville, Pennsylvania in 1859, the American oil boom began with a major gusher at Spindletop in 1901 near Beaumont, Texas.

The largest "conventional" <u>oil field</u> is Saudi Arabia's Ghawar oil field. Containing nearly 50 billion barrels of oil, the field is able to produce 3.8 million barrels per day.

Saudi Arabia produces 8.1 million barrels of oil per day.
