The D&D Standard Oil and Gas Abbreviator

Many of you may recognize D&D as associated with Desk and Derrick. But you may not know what the Standard Oil & Gas Abbreviator is, or its history.

In keeping with its educational goal, ADDC printed the D&D Standard Oil Abbreviator, a handbook of commonly used terms and phrases in the oil industry and their shorthand connotations, in 1965. This book was developed from an idea proposed by Bettye Lyn Hatcher of Monahans, Texas, member of the Desk and Derrick Club of Monahans. She presented the idea in a feature story in her Club's bulletin, The Direct Line. Her story described the plight of a young secretary on her first assignment with an oil company, trying to decipher the strange looking language in a drilling report. With no key to unlock the mystery of this language, she was completely lost.

Contributions came from members of all Clubs and in all branches of the industry, from exploration to marketing. Every effort was made to make the first product as complete as possible. To this day, through the PennWell Corporation, ADDC members provide updates to the D&D Standard Oil & Gas Abbreviator.

This best-selling guide offers more than 11,500 definitions of oil field terms. In its sixth edition, it provides valuable information about:

- Abbreviations with Definitions
- Definitions with Abbreviations
- Abbreviations for Logging Tools and Services
- Federal Environmental Acronyms
- Pipe Coating Terminology and Definitions
- Mnemonics Service Names and Computational Products
- Abbreviations for Companies, Associations, and Organizations in U.S. and Canada
- Abbreviations for Companies, Associations, and Organizations outside U.S. and Canada
- Common Oilfield Spellings
- API Standard Oil Mapping Symbols
- Mathematical symbols and signs
- Frequently Cited Chemical Abbreviations
- Frequently Cited Additives Abbreviations
- Frequently Cited Fluids Used as Cushion Abbreviations

This is an indispensable tool in the oil, gas and energy industries. The information included in this book has made writing tasks within energy and its related industries simpler and has, through the years, added consistency to industry reports.

The Ad-Hoc Committee would like to present our final recommendations for consideration of proposing bylaw amendments.

- Dissolution of the four regions of ADDC
 - a. Eliminate Region Directors
 - Eliminate Region Meetings
 - Region funds distributed according to Region Fund Bylaws
- Create two 'Communications Director' board positions
 - Communications Director(s) serves as the liaison between ADDC Clubs & ADDC Board of Directors
 - No distinction of geographical areas. The ADDC Board shall divide the clubs under a Director based on current membership at B&P.
 - Qualifications: Shall have served or be serving as a Club President; must be willing to communicate with Clubs and serve as their voice to the ADDC Board.
 - Elected according to current ADDC Bylaws Article IX, Section 2
 - e. Caveat if membership falls below 300, position would automatically reduce to one Communications Director without the requirement of bylaw amendments to approve.
- Restructure ADDC Committees
 - a. Chairman, Board Contact and 1-2 volunteers (as needed)
 - b. AIMEE's presented only at Convention
 - Chairman, Board Contact and 3-4 volunteers
 - Chairman assigns clubs to obtain judges for each category
- Convention Hosting
 - ADDC Board assumes GAC role and assigns committee based on location where Convention will be held.

If the proposed bylaw amendments pass at Convention in 2025, we recommend a special vote following Convention to determine the two Communications Director(s) from the pool of 2026 Region Director-Elects so the position would be effective January 1st, 2026.

I would like to thank the members of the Ad-Hoc committee who gave valuable input during our discussions so we could present what we feel is a beneficial change to allow our organization to keep moving forward; Jamie Gilmore (Central), Penny Jacobs (Northeast), Malissa Carroll (Southeast) and JoAnn Weiss (West).
